To Report a Case of Child Abuse or Neglect: call the **Division of Youth and Family Services** (DYFS) at: 1-877-NJABUSE (1-877-652-2873). In New Jersey every citizen, no matter what their occupation or relationship to the child, who comes in contact and observes behavior or conditions that might indicate abuse or neglect is required by law to report their suspicions. Then state authorities can investigate and take appropriate action.

For children between the ages of 5 to 17 who have emotional or behavioral problems and for young adults ages 18 to 21 call **Value Options** at 1-877-652-7624.

For Mobile Crisis Response (will respond to home or school within one hour) call **Value Options** at 1-877-652-7624 For the Hearing Impaired call 1-866-896-6975 (TDD); on site response to diffuse an emotional/behavioral disturbance that endangers the child's continued placement in their living arrangement.
